



## **Part-Time Physician Trainer, National Center for Clinical Skills Testing**

The National Board of Osteopathic Medical Examiners (NBOME) is seeking an enthusiastic osteopathic physician to serve as a Part-Time Physician Trainer for its National Center for Clinical Skills Testing, which administers the Comprehensive Osteopathic Medical Licensing Examination Level 2-Performance Evaluation (COMLEX Level 2-PE).

This physician will be in the position to assist the department of clinical skills testing in a variety of areas, such as Standardized Patient-related activities (portrayal accuracy, mock encounters, training, assisting in maintenance of PE Database), SOAP Note-related activities (scoring, screening for accuracy and misrepresentation of clinical findings, physician examiner training), coordination of candidate surveys (onsite and web-based), staff wellness activities, and research related to clinical skills testing.

The selected individual will report directly to the Vice President for Clinical Skills Testing, but will work closely with other staff and physician trainers. This Regular Part-time position requires the individual to be physically present at the National Center for Clinical Skills Testing in Conshohocken (a suburb of Philadelphia). He/she will be required to work 15 hours per week. While scheduling of these 15 hours is flexible, they must occur between the hours of 7:30 am to 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday.

Requirements for the position include a minimum of three (3) years of clinical experience. Preference will be given to those with clinical skills testing or standardized patient experience. Osteopathic physicians from all disciplines or subspecialties will be considered for the position.
